| HUMBLE             | <b>Realizes his successes have come from help he/she receives from others - Prov. 16:18-19, 1 Peter 5:5b-6</b><br><i>(Arrogant and prideful)</i>   |        |

| RESPECTFUL    | <b>Recognizes the worth or authority of others - 1 Thes. 5:12-13</b><br><i>(Sassy - tries to show by action or attitude that he/she is better than others)</i> |  |
| GENEROUS      | <b>Shares with a happy spirit - 2 Cor. 9:7</b><br><i>(Selfish - shares grudgingly, if at all)</i>  |  |
| FAIR          | <b>Treats others equally - Luke 6:31, James 2:1-4, 9</b><br><i>(Favoritism - treats some better than others, making others feel mistreated)</i>                |  |
| ACCEPTING     | <b>Easily shares himself/herself with others, even if they are different - Act 10:34-35</b><br><i>(Prejudice - rejects others on a superficial basis)</i>      |  |

| ATTENTIVE    | <b>Listens with eyes, ears, and heart - Prov. 4:20-23</b><br><i>(Insensitive - doesn't pay attention, ignores people)</i>  |  |
| DILIGENT     | <b>Works hard to accomplish a task - Col. 3:23-24, 2 Tim. 2:15</b><br><i>(Slothfulness - doesn't care how well tasks are done)</i>                               |  |
| COMMITTED    | <b>Stays with a task until it is successfully done - Titus 3:8</b><br><i>(Fickle - changes tasks often without completing any well, not persistent)</i>          |  |
| RELIABLE     | <b>Is trustworthy - 1 Cor. 4:2</b><br><i>(Undependable - can't count on him/her, even when he/she promises; may or may not do it)</i>                            |  |
| RESPONSIBLE  | <b>Does what he/she knows he should do without constant reminding - 1 Cor. 4:2, Luke 16:10a</b><br><i>(Irresponsible - has to be "nagged" to get tasks done)</i> |  |
| CREATIVE     | <b>Does things a new way - Gen 1:31</b><br><i>(Uncreative - gets into a rut, does not try new ways, prefers status-quo)</i>                                      |  |
