CONFIDENT	Finds God's words, commands, and promises a firm foundation for living - Is. 32:17, Prov. 3:21-26 <i>(Insecure - focuses on own strength - calls on God only in emergencies)</i>	
CONTENT	Is happy with what he/she has - 1 Tim. 6:6 <i>(Dissatisfied - wants more, especially what his/her friends have)</i>	
MEEK	Accepts circumstances with quietness - Titus 3:2 <i>(Anger - is unhappy when things don't go his/her own way)</i>	
JOYFUL	Is happy inside and out - Phil. 4:4 <i>(Unhappy - may try to look happy to the world, but isn't inside)</i>	
HUMBLE	Realizes his successes have come from help he/she receives from others - Prov. 16:18-19, 1 Peter 5:5b-6 <i>(Arrogant and prideful)</i>	

Actions Toward Others:

FORGIVING	Treats another as though that person had not hurt him/her - Col. 3:3, 1 Thes. 5:15 <i>(Revenge - bears grudges, tries to get even for real or imagined hurts)</i>	
PATIENT	Waits with a happy spirit - James 5:8, Gal. 5:22, Phil. 4:6 <i>(Fretfulness - wants things immediately)</i>	
THANKFUL	Is grateful to others and says so - 1 Thes. 5:18 <i>(Ingratitude - is ungrateful, or doesn't express appreciation to others)</i>	
HELPFUL	Is ready to serve others - Isa. 41:6a <i>(Self-serving - helps only when not inconvenienced)</i>

CHARACTER TRAIT	DEFINITION	RESULT
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Relationships with Others:

FRIENDLY	Eagerly shares himself/herself with others - Prov. 18:24a <i>(Unsociable - finds it difficult to make friends, feels others don't like him/her)</i>	
KIND	Has gentle words and ways - Eph. 4:32, Phil. 4:5 <i>(Meanness - does or says things that hurt others' feelings)</i>	
TENDERHEARTED	Feels the hurts of others and tries to help - Eph. 4:32, Col. 3:12 <i>(Uncaring - doesn't notice the difficulties of others)</i>	
RESPECTFUL	Recognizes the worth or authority of others - 1 Thes. 5:12-13 <i>(Sassy - tries to show by action or attitude that he/she is better than others)</i>	
GENEROUS	Shares with a happy spirit - 2 Cor. 9:7 <i>(Selfish - shares grudgingly, if at all)</i>	
FAIR	Treats others equally - Luke 6:31, James 2:1-4, 9 <i>(Favoritism - treats some better than others, making others feel mistreated)</i>	
ACCEPTING	Easily shares himself/herself with others, even if they are different - Act 10:34-35 <i>(Prejudice - rejects others on a superficial basis)</i>	

Task Orientation:

SELF-CONTROL	Will do something, even when he/she doesn't feel like it - Prov. 25:28 <i>(Self-indulgence - does "their own thing," put his/her desires first)</i>	
INITIATIVE	Sees what needs to be done and does it - Prov. 6:6-8 <i>(Hesitant - waits for others to take the lead)</i>	
ATTENTIVE	Listens with eyes, ears, and heart - Prov. 4:20-23 <i>(Insensitive - doesn't pay attention, ignores people)</i>	
DILIGENT	Works hard to accomplish a task - Col. 3:23-24, 2 Tim. 2:15 <i>(Slothfulness - doesn't care how well tasks are done)</i>	
COMMITTED	Stays with a task until it is successfully done - Titus 3:8 <i>(Fickle - changes tasks often without completing any well, not persistent)</i>	
RELIABLE	Is trustworthy - 1 Cor. 4:2 <i>(Undependable - can't count on him/her, even when he/she promises; may or may not do it)</i>	
RESPONSIBLE	Does what he/she knows he should do without constant reminding - 1 Cor. 4:2, Luke 16:10a <i>(Irresponsible - has to be "nagged" to get tasks done)</i>	
CREATIVE	Does things a new way - Gen 1:31 <i>(Uncreative - gets into a rut, does not try new ways, prefers status-quo)</i>

OBEDIENT	Does what he/she told to do quickly and willingly - 1 Sam. 15:22b <i>(Disobedient - obeys grudgingly, is rebellious)</i>	
ORDERLY	Takes care of his/her things and is neat - 1 Cor. 14:40 <i>(Disorganized - confusion, things are always getting lost, messy)</i>	
HONEST	Has truthful words and truthful ways - Col. 3:9 <i>(Lies - is not truthful in words and/or actions)</i>
