Spring Beginning Drawing Club

Open to FCS students in Grades 2 through 5

Cost: \$165

Day/Time: Mondays from 3:15 – 4:30 pm Dates: Begins 2/7, ends 5/23 (12 sessions)

Meets in Room 355

Class Size: Minimum of 6 / maximum of 18

Description:

This class will be a continuation of what students learned in the fall course, but newcomers are welcome! I will focus on teaching the students basic drawing techniques and styles of shading to transform their work into realistic drawings. Students will be able to use the tools they learn in this class, to incorporate into any drawings they continue with on their pathway of art. We will be focusing on an array of techniques, from solid figures to designs and patterns, perspective, and optical illusions. This spring course will be a longer running session than in the fall to include 12 classes. Students may bring a small snack for the beginning of club.

All materials are included in the course fee, which include 9x12 drawing pad, quality drawing pencil set, gum eraser, kneaded eraser, rubber eraser, tortillons, carry bag, and building use fee.

Advanced Drawing Club

Open to FCS students in Grades 4 through 8

Cost: \$165

Day/Time: Tuesday from 3:30 – 4:45 pm Dates: Begins 2/8, ends 5/10 (12 sessions)

Meets in Room 355

Class Size: Minimum of 6 / maximum of 18

Description:

This class will be focusing on an array of techniques, with zentangle/mandala designs, anime characters, fantasy, optical illusions, free choice designs, perspective, and shading. Students will engage in more detailed designs and illustrations. Students bring a small snack for the beginning of club.

All materials are included in the course fee, which include 9x12 drawing pad, quality drawing pencil set, gum eraser, kneaded eraser, rubber eraser, tortillons, carry bag, and building use fee. This spring course will be a longer running session than in the fall to include 12 classes.

Open to FCS students in Grades 4 and 5

Cost: \$175 per student per semester

Day/Time: Mondays from 3:15 – 4:30, or Wednesdays from 3:15 – 4:30 except days when FCS is not in

session

Dates: Begins the week of 2/7 and 2/9/22, ends the week of 6/1

Meets in the Music Room Class size: Maximum of 26 total

Prerequisite: Students must have either already taken the first session of band club in the fall **or** have had some other form of instruction on their instrument. If your child was not in fall band club contact Ms. Nykiel before signing up.

Description:

Band is open to students in 4th and 5th grade who are interested in continuing to learn their band instrument. Instruments include Flute, Clarinet, Alto Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Baritone (Euphonium), Percussion (Not Drum Set). If your child plays an instrument not on the list, but that you think may fit with the band, please contact Ms. Nykiel.

50 - 75 minutes or more of at home practice is expected every week. A Spring concert is planned. Students will meet either Monday or Wednesday. Students will be divided by Ms. Nykiel, based on instrument groups and level. If your child is currently meeting on Monday or Wednesday there is a good chance that will continue to be their club day, however, there could be some changes depending on the number of students that sign up for Spring. There is flexibility if your schedule only allows for a certain day.

As we draw closer to the Spring Concert there will be some weeks where students will need to come on both club days to practice playing as one larger group.
