- Mrs. Brigner has accepted a full time teaching position at FCS (4<sup>th</sup> grade) & will assist the PTO with used uniform sales in the best manner possible
- Ginny Lee stated that the PTO may have a table present with information for any meet-ngreets or back to school night to seek more members

## **Financial Update**

- Paul Lowe is still waiting for some statement reports to update the financial documents
- Mr. Lowe is looking for information on the Ledo's pizza fundraiser
- Mr. Lowe reported that the account has shown an increase in funds
- Per Mrs. Renkema, PTO Vice President, some of those funds will still be used for the current special fund requests
- Lydia Parris will reconcile some withdrawals, and Jennifer Renkema is requesting that we receive the budget in a clear form for all to view
