 with PTA at another school where her son attended, works as teacher in high school, &
 participates in other roles at work, such as: coaching, yearbook staff, & other activities

- after launching, & served at the committee level; Mr. Paul Lowe will remain as an assistant in preparing financial statements as needed in support of this role

- All PTO members present voted "yes" to elect the new PTO executive board, for a unanimous vote
- Mrs. Renkema thanked Mrs. Parris & Mrs. Lecy-Alvarado for their service as officers over the past 2 school years

Fundraising Committee

- Per Martha Arteaga, chairperson, Kona Ice March 31st fundraiser raised \$180; will consider staggering the lines by spacing out the different grades to improve crowd control & decrease time to receive product when this vendor returns at a later, undetermined date

- Spring Fling is scheduled for May 20th, & this committee will send out the sponsor flyers soon

- Per Martha Arteaga, in place of excused chairperson Mel Masta, this committee is continuing its work to support the school's spring Gala fundraiser

- FCS community is encouraged to purchase tickets, & children participating in the event will receive a free meal

- Teacher Appreciation Week is scheduled from May 8th to May 12th, & activities will include: catered lunch, sidewalk chalk messages from FCS community, possibly the heart cart (drink/snack cart around the building), cards given out by students to their teachers/staff

Other Volunteer Efforts & Other Business

- Per Mrs. Brigner, the "Bottom Dollar" used uniform sale was originally scheduled for April 14th, however, due to another school meeting, it will now be scheduled on April 21st
- PTO members are encouraged to contact Mrs. Brigner to volunteer to set up, sell, and/or clean up after the used uniform sale
- The library is collected gently used books for the used book sale that will take place at the end of the school year; bins are located in the front of the school for drop off

- The funding requests for staff are due April 14th (deadline) & will be discussed with the PTO executive board to present to the PTO members for voice vote during the next general PTO meeting
