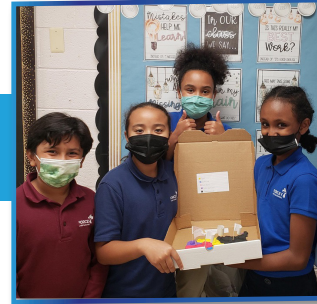
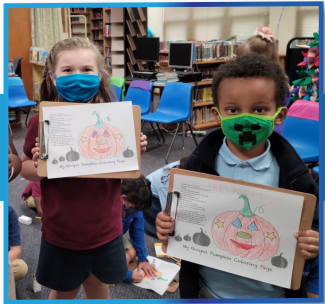


# Exemplary Academics, Spiritual Growth, and Community
