Cost: \$175 Day/Time: Mondays from 3:15 – 4:30 except days when FCS is not in session Dates: Begins 9/11, ends 12/4 Meets in the Music Room Class size: Maximum of 18

Description:

Band is open to 4th and 5th grade first year band students who are interested in learning how to play an instrument. Band is a fun experience to express yourself, learn how to play your favorite songs on an instrument, and develop a new understanding of music. Your student is not expected to decide which instrument they want to play before signing up for band. Mr. Haftel will offer opportunities to learn about and try instruments. Available options for instruments include Flute, Clarinet, Alto Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Euphonium, or Percussion. **The rental of an instrument from a local music store is your responsibility if you sign your student up for band.** This includes percussionists, who are expected to purchase or rent a bell kit. More information will be provided about how to rent an instrument.
